

JSPCA Animals' Shelter Rehoming Process



Rehoming a Dog

Stage 1

- Fill out an application form (available from JSPCA Reception or website) to rehome a dog and hand in to reception.
- Please note your form will be kept on file for 1 year.

Stage 2

- JSPCA will call you when they have a suitable dog for you.
- Alternatively, if you see a dog advertised on the JSPCA's social media or website please contact the JSPCA reception expressing interest.

Stage 3

- If a dog is suitable for you you will be asked to come in for a chat with one of our kennel team and viewing of the dog.
- Please bring with you Landlord Permission (if you rent) and proof of address (utility bill) dated within the last 2 months.

Stage 4

- If the JSPCA and yourself feel your home is suitable for the dog you will be asked to come in for a certain amount of viewings and training which is dependent on the dog and their requirements.
- A home visit will also be required.

Stage 5

- Once your home visit has been approved, the required amount of viewings and training have been completed and the kennel team are happy with the bond between yourself and the dog you will be able to adopt the dog and they will be reserved for you.
- A payment for adopting a dog from the JSPCA is required. This is to cover the overhead costs of preparing a dog for rehoming.
- Paperwork is to be completed on adoption, the reception team will assist with this.

Stage 6

- Once you have adopted the dog, please choose a private veterinary practice you wish to take your pet to. Once you have found a private veterinary practice please let our reception team know so they can transfer your pet's medical history.

Please note that if we have a lot of interest in an animal, we will select the most suitable home for that animal and their needs.
