

JSPCA Animals' Shelter Rehoming Process

Foster Dog



Stage 1

- Fill out an application form (available from JSPCA Reception or website) to rehome a dog and hand in to reception.
- Please note your form will be kept on file for 1 year.

Stage 2

- JSPCA will call you when they have a suitable dog for you and will mention that the dog is on our foster scheme.
- Alternatively, if you see a dog advertised on the JSPCA's social media or website please contact the JSPCA reception expressing interest.

Stage 3

- If a dog is suitable for you you will be asked to come in for a chat with one of our kennel team and viewing of the dog.
- Please bring with you Landlord Permission (if you rent) and proof of address (utility bill) dated within the last 2 months.

Stage 4

- Overview of the AVC Clinic will be provided prior to your first viewing
- If the JSPCA and yourself feel your home is suitable for the dog you will be asked to come in for a certain amount of viewings and training which is dependent on the dog and their requirements.
- A home visit will also be required.
- As the dog is a foster you will need to attend a Foster Chat with the veterinary surgeon who is looking after that dogs case. You will be asked to arrange this with reception.

Stage 5

- Once your home visit has been approved, you have attended a foster chat with one of our vets, the required amount of viewings and training have been completed and the kennel team are happy with the bond between yourself and the dog you will be able to adopt the dog and they will be reserved for you.
- A payment for fostering a dog from the JSPCA is required. This is to cover the overhead costs of preparing a dog for rehoming.
- Paperwork is to be completed on fostering, the reception team will assist with this.

Stage 6

- Due to the dog being a foster, you are able to bring the dog to the JSPCA for ongoing veterinary care at a reduced cost compared to private veterinary practices.
- If you would like to take your foster dog to a private vet practice you will need to let reception know and fully adopt your dog and sign some additional paperwork

Please note that if we have a lot of interest in an animal, we will select the most suitable home for that animal and their needs.
