JSPCA Animals' Shelter Rehoming Process **CATS**



1

Fill out an application form at Reception or online. This form will be kept for a maximum of one year.



2

You will receive a call from the JSPCA if we have a suitable cat for you. Alternatively, if you see a cat advertised on the JSPCA website or social media, please contact our Reception to express interest.

3

If a cat is a suitable match for you, you will be asked to come in for a chat with one of our cattery team and to meet the cat. We will ask to see Landlord's permission (if you live in rented accommodation) and proof of address (e.g. a utility bill) from the past two months.

4

If the JSPCA team feel that you and your home is suitable for the cat, you will be asked to come in for a certain number of viewings. This is dependent on the cat's requirements. If the cat has an underlying medical condition, you will need to book in a Vet chat with one of our veterinary surgeons, so information regarding their condition can be explained to you. A home visit will also be required.

5

Once you have had your Vet chat (if required), home visit has been approved, the required number of viewings has taken place, and the cattery team is happy with the bond between you and the cat, you will be able to adopt the cat and they will be reserved for you. You will then need to register the cat with a private Vet practice and the JSPCA will send over the cat's history. The JSPCA asks for a minimum donation for adopting an animal. This is to cover some of the overhead costs of preparing them for rehoming. Paperwork is then to be completed on adoption - the Reception team will assist.

6

Once everyone is happy that everything is completed, you'll be able to arrange a time with the cattery team to collect your cat and take them home.
